


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University-business cooperation



Assessment criteria – Specific label for dual learning

- 25-50% ECTS in collaboration with companies (end of degree project included)
- Involvement degree of companies in the design/development/review
- Expected/achieved learning outcomes
- Student-company bond (contract or similar)
- Profile of the tutors (training)
- Included in their IQAS

Methodology

- Mapping the current situation of the university-business cooperation in the Basque University System focusing on:
 - ➤ Dual learning curriculum
 - ➤ Professional skills
 - ➤ Internships (compulsory
 - or voluntary)
- Developing of assessment criteria –
 Specific label for dual learning

Conclusions

- Wide options for university-business cooperation
- Dual learning at university level is increasing its visibility in the Basque Country
- Specific label might help some other study programmes to follow the same path
- Need of flexibility, but with clear rules
