CV SUMMARY**

M.I Gracia has a Degree in Geography and History (1986), and a PhD in General History and Geography (1994), at University of Barcelona. She obtained the Extraordinary Doctorate Award (1995) and the First award in "Cultural Research Marqués de Lozoya" (1995). She has developed as professor at the University of Barcelona (1994-8), at ICADE-Universidad Pontificia de Comillas (1995-2000) and at the Universitat Rovira i Virgili (1995-present). She has been recognized as Professor since 2006 and more recently as Full Professor, teaching undergraduate and master and teaching subjects of anthropological theory and ethnography. She has directed 9 theses that have obtained the maximum qualification and is supervising 11 doctoral students. Her research line is between the anthropology of food and health. Her work on gender, food and body carried out in Spain and Mexico has focused on the analysis of transformations, ruptures and continuities in food cultures, and the problematization of food and body practices, questioning her about the overlap between the biological and social and the relevance of dialogue with other disciplines. This line has been nurtured and consolidated by participating and directing regional, state and international projects belonging to competitive calls (National R&D Plan, EU Framework Program, H2020, Gender Institute). The results have been presented in state and international conferences and have been disseminated through scientific publications. She has published more than a dozen books and a hundred and a half

articles in journals and book chapters written in Spanish, English, French, Portuguese and Catalan. Some of these books has been reprinted, such as *Somos lo que Comemos* (2002-08), *Liquid Bread* (2011-13), *Dictionnaire des Cultures Alimentaires* (2012, 2018), or translated into other languages, such as *Alimentação, Sociedade e Cultura* (2011). At the same time, she has expanded her training and experience doing various internships in national and foreign academic centers, having been invited as a Visiting Fellow by the institutions of destination or supported by scholarships and grants from the Ministry of Education and Culture, the Generalitat de Catalunya and Fundación Carolina. This is the case of the Center of CIESAS (Mexico), University of Toulouse (France), National Institute of Medical Sciences and Nutrition Salvador Zubirán (Mexico), Universidade do Minho (Portugal), State University of Rio de Janeiro and Universidade de São Paulo (Brazil), Durham University (GB) or SOAS Food Studies Center (GB).

She has also committed to academic management. She has been Head of the Department of Anthropology, Philosophy and Social Work (2016-2020). She has been part of the decanal team of the Faculty of Arts (2007-14), Head of Studies of the Degree in Social and Cultural Anthropology and the Degree in Anthropology and Human Evolution (2008-14) and Coordinator of Mobility of Teachers and Students (2008-11). She has participated in various faculty commissions, as well as in other tasks related to the academic activity (evaluator of projects, scientific and editorial committees, reviewer, networks, member of scientific associations). She is currently Director of the Social Anthropology Research Group (2017SGR23). As a result of this teaching, research and management work she has obtained 4 sections of teaching, the recognition of teaching excellence by the Catalan University Quality Assurance Agency, 2 term of management and 4 six-year terms investigation.
