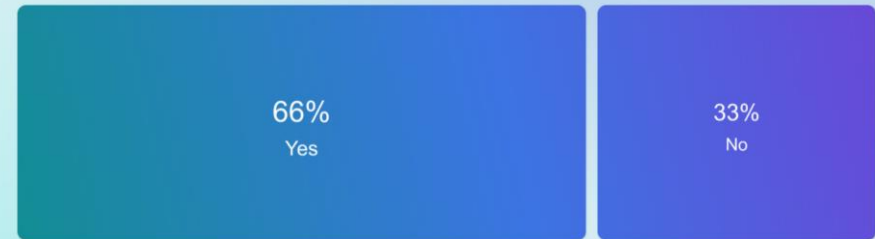

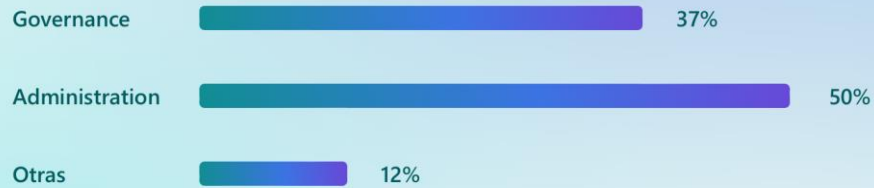

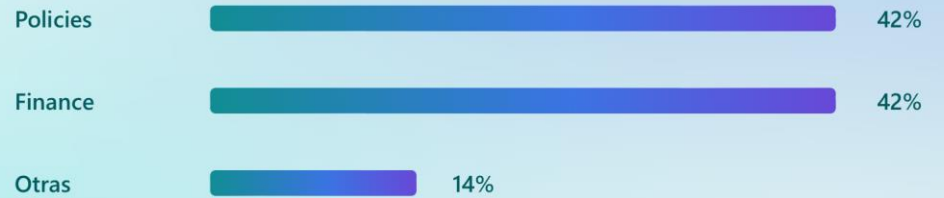

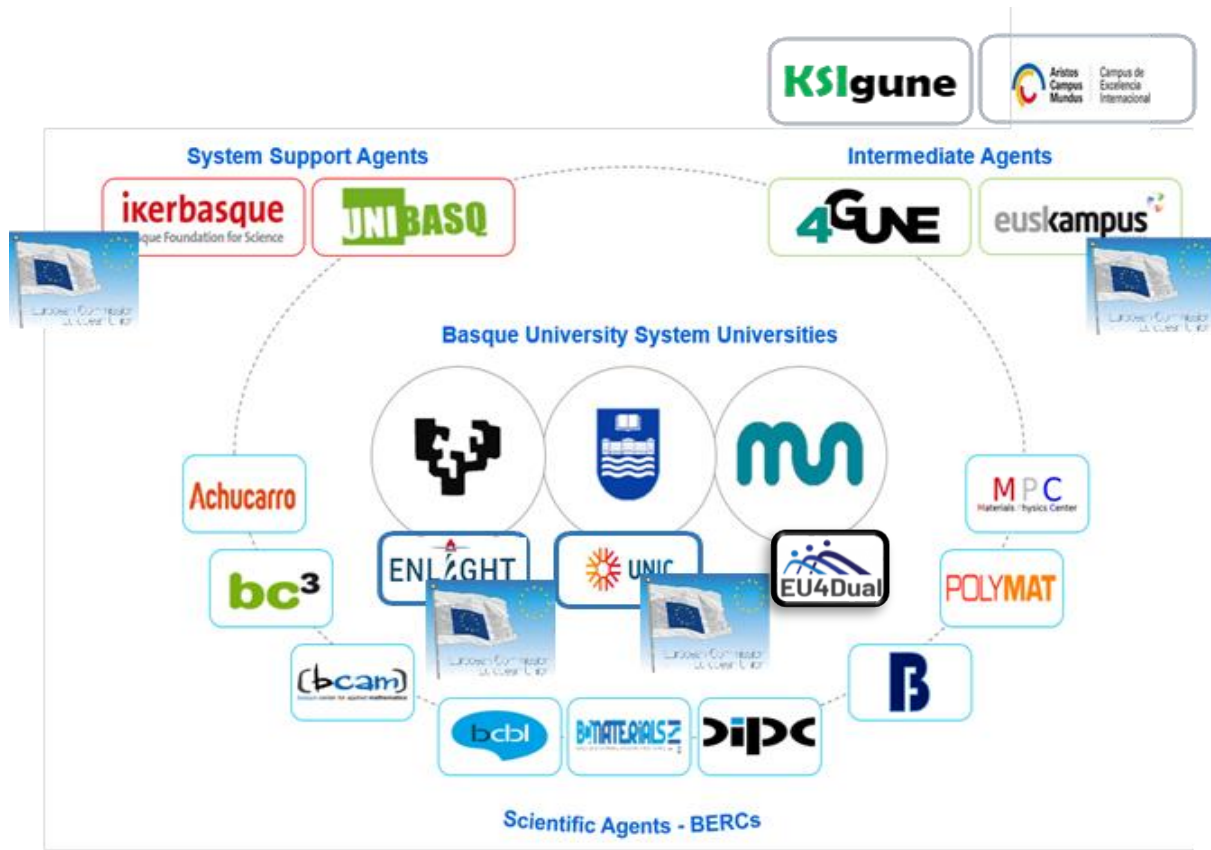

The Basque University plans

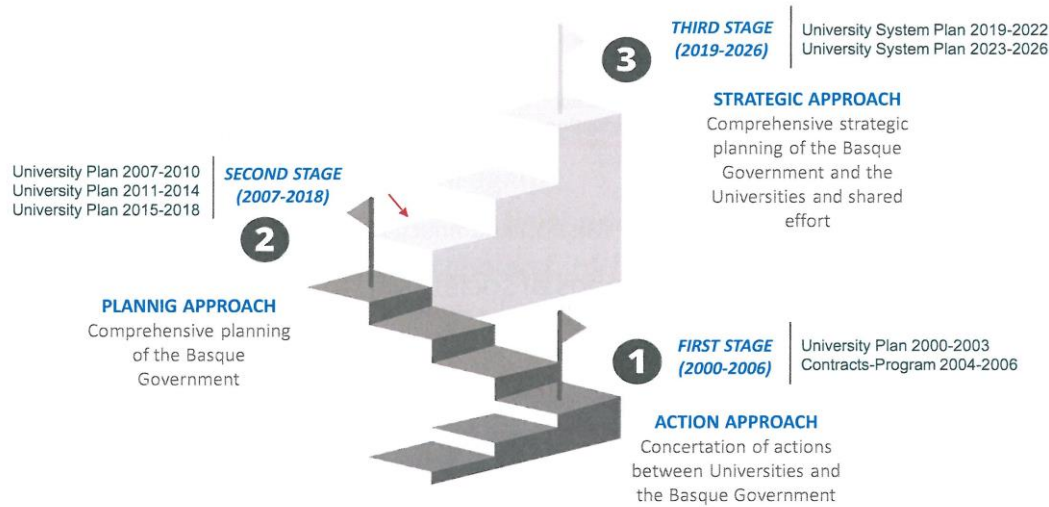


Figure 3: Evolution of the planning of university policies in the Basque Country.
